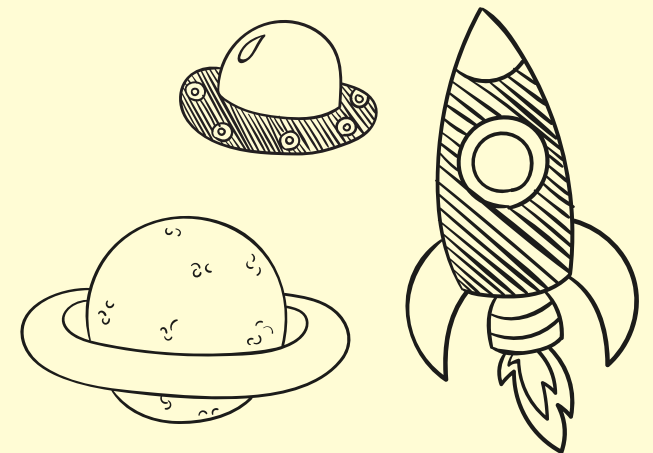




INTRODUCTION

But it is not possible for everyone as its coaching is so expensive and they have to send away the apple of their eyes far from them. Keeping these parents in view, VVN has taken the responsibility of making their dreams come true by initiating coaching for JEE and NEET Foundation in the campus from classes 9th to 12th. Experienced and qualified faculty has been hired for it. It is running successfully in this session.

HOSTEL FACILITY

Vivekanand Vidya Niketan, Assandh provides hostel facility for the students for class VI onwards. Well furnished rooms with hygienically cooked well balanced meals, secured and studious environment including other facilities can be availed by the Boarders at very competitive charges.

SALIENT FEATURES



Well Furnished Rooms – The hostel rooms are adequately furnished. We provide a separate bed with mattress, a study table and a chair and a wardrobe to each student. Each dormitory is looked after by wardens and other supportive staff.

Dining Facilities – Dining Hall where food is served in clean and hygienic conditions. Pest free surroundings. Purified cold and warm water (during winters) is provided to the students. Fresh hygienic and nutritious food is available in the form of breakfast, lunch, snacks and dinner. A diet chart is followed taking into consideration that adequate proportion of all the nutrients are present in the diet of every student. The mess menu is well planned. Special meals are provided on festival days.

Medical Facility – The infirmary is run and managed under the guidance of qualified nurse. We have a tie up with few other prominent hospitals of the city which provide emergency treatment.

Security – To ensure safety and security of the students, we have deployed Security Guards around the clock in the hostel which is further beefed up with CCTV Cameras in the hostel. Proper procedure is followed for issuing of Out-Passes and allowing visitors to the hostel.

Studious Environment- The Day-Boarding & Residential staff takes tutorial Classes for solving students' problems and supports them in their academic studies. A studious atmosphere is provided to the boarders in which a student develops a sound work ethics through a structured study programme.

Physical Fitness -Sports, Indoor Games & Common Room – We have facility to play basketball, cricket, Badminton etc. Indoor games like Table Tennis, Carom Board ,Chess etc are available to keep boarders fit and healthy.

Entertainment & Outings – A break over the weekend is welcome. We arrange screening of popular movies and projection of important sport events on the big screen in the campus amphitheatre. Once in a month there will be an outing for hostel students to the city in school bus under the supervision of the Wardens

ADMISSIONS

Primary & Secondary Classes

Admission to classes I to IX will be granted subject to availability of vacant seats and qualifying the entrance test by the students. Registration does not guarantee admission.

Senior Secondary Classes

A student who has qualified the Xth standard with minimum 50% marks or at least C grade will be eligible for admission to 11th Standard Science (Non-medical) and Commerce Stream after qualifying the entrance test and availability of vacant seats

No direct admission is allowed in 10th & 12th Standard

COURSES AVAILABLE IN SENIOR SECONDARY SECTION

Parents are required to give one month's advance written notice to the school authorities for the withdrawal of their children. The Transfer Certificate is issued only after the school's dues have been cleared for the complete academic session.

Non-Medical Group : English, Physics, Chemistry, Maths, Physical Education, Music, IP, Painting

Medical Group : English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Physical Education, Music, IP, Painting

Commerce Group : English, Maths/Economics, Physical Education, Business Studies
Accountancy and Work Experience, Music, IP, Painting

Humanity Group (Only for Girls) : English, Hindi, Maths, History, Physical Education, Music, IP, Painting

- 1 The academic session is from the 1st April to the 31st March.
- 2 Advanced registration is compulsory for the new admission to the school. Admission fee is to be deposited within a week of the Admission Test, failing in doing so the admission will be cancelled and the seat is declared vacant.
- 3 It must be noted that mere registration does not guarantee admission, which will chiefly depend on the combined test given at the time of admission. This consists of a common Written Test to assess the suitability of the pupil for a particular class. The Written Test is followed by the Personality and Physical-cum-Medical fitness tests.
- 4 The School Authority reserves the exclusive right to decide the class to which a pupil can be admitted.

REMOVALS AND WITHDRAWALS

- 1 The Principal reserves the right to cancel the admission of a student whose performance and progress in studies are unsatisfactory or whose conduct is harmful to the interest and prestige of the institution.
- 2 A student who fails in the same class twice will automatically be removed from the rolls of the school.
- 3 Any student caught using unfair means during an examination will not be retained on the school rolls.
- 4 In case a student stops attending the school without any prior information to the school authorities, his/her name will be struck off from the school rolls after six consecutive days of absence.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION

- 1 Proof of the Date of Birth from the Municipality or any other competent authority
- 2 Mark sheet of the previous class
- 3 SLC/TC issued by the school last attended
- 4 Migration Certificate, if any
- 5 School/Board Registration Number, if any
- 6 Four copies of the passport-size photographs of the child and one photo /each of the parent and the guardian or the person authorised to visit the child on their behalf.

Note: Particulars of a child will remain the same as mentioned in the SLC issued by the previous school according to the CBSE rules

SCHOOL RULES

- 1 Parents/Guardians are expected to sincerely observe all the rules and regulations of the school which may be enforced from time to time. In case of a dispute, the decision of the Principal will be final and binding on them.
- 2 Throughout his/her stay in the school, a student will be governed by the strict Code of Discipline of the school.
- 3 A minimum of 75% attendance is a must for promotion to the next class.
- 4 Every student shall always carry the Identity Card with him/her for the identification purposes.
- 5 Students' participation in all the functions and activities of the School is compulsory.
- 6 All the students shall converse in English in the School Campus.
- 7 All the students shall follow the school dress code.
- 8 Any damage to the school property, caused by negligence or mischief shall have to be compensated by the defaulter. The quantum of such damage done shall be determined by the Principal for the payment purposes.
- 9 Retention or consumption of any unauthorized and unlawful material is strictly prohibited on the school campus.
- 10 Fine will be imposed on the students for violating the school norms eg coming to school without wearing the prescribed uniform, not bringing books/notebooks, causing any damage to the school property, coming late, remaining absent, using any local language etc.
- 11 An act of indiscipline may lead to expulsion of the child from the school.
- 12 No student is allowed to come to school by bike or by car in case he/she does not possess a valid driving license.
- 13 Change of subjects and sections is not permissible in any case.
- 14 Parents must reach the school on receiving the telephonic call from the school in case of an emergency or a complaint against their child/children.
- 15 The school shall not be responsible for any miss-happening on account of some natural calamity like earthquake, flood, fire, etc. However, training in disaster management is given regularly
- 16 The school shall not be responsible for any injury received by the student while undertaking any academic or extra curricular activities in or out of the school eg Practical Exam, Sports, Trips & Tours, nor shall it bear any expenses incurred thereupon.
- 17 The school rules can be modified at any point during an academic session without any prior information and these modified rules will be applicable to all old and new admissions
- 18 Persons carrying arms shall not be allowed to enter the school premises in any case

- 19 Aptitudes, capabilities and interests do vary from person to person. Hence, a child's academic performance should never be compared with that of others, however, the school puts in its sincerest effort for an all round development of its students.
- 20 The school shall not be responsible for loss or damage to any board documents, if they are not collected from the school counter within three months from the date of issue by the board.
- 21 The parents must confirm the reliability of the outside transport provider before arranging transport for their child. The school shall not be responsible for it in any case.
- 22 If any parent wants that no other person should meet his/her child without his/her consent, a written application for the same will have to be submitted to the Principal at the time of admission.
- 23 The school may send an SMS or an e-mail to the parents regarding any information about the children so as to seek their cooperation to monitor the children for their smooth progress.
- 24 The parent has to submit a copy of his/her child's yearly medical checkup report and an incidental/accidental policy receipt to the class teacher concerned at the time of admission.
