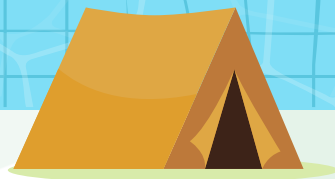
POOL PARTY OF LITTLE VYNTITES

HARYALI TEEJ CELEBRATION

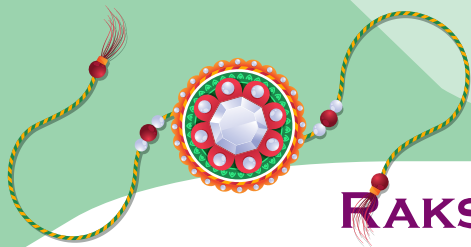
Life becomes a festival when Gaitey and Culture blend.
